10:15	<p>Guided tour of the Reina Sofía Museum</p> <p>The Reina Sofía Museum is one of the main points of reference for contemporary art in Spain. The guided visit to the museum will consist of a tour of its permanent collection, focusing on great Spanish artists of the 20th century, especially Pablo Picasso (Guernica), Salvador Dalí and Joan Miró. Housed in a renovated former hospital, the museum combines history and the avant-garde in a unique space in the heart of Madrid.</p>
13:15	<p>Lunch at Arzábal</p> <p>Arzábal, located in the Reina Sofía Museum, offers an outstanding gastronomic experience with creative Mediterranean cuisine in a cosy and elegant atmosphere. This restaurant perfectly complements the visit to the museum, fusing art and flavour in a unique space.</p>

Stroll along the boulevards of Las Rozas Village and discover the latest collections for a unique shopping experience.</p>
13:15	<p>Lunch at Asador Agasti</p> <p>Asador Sidrería Sagasti is a representative and benchmark of Basque cuisine in Madrid, one of the most renowned in Spain for the variety and quality of its ingredients, thanks to the region's privileged climate. Sagasti's culinary offering is based on two classic pillars of traditional Basque cuisine: pinchos (tapas) and the asador-sidrería (grill and cider house), so well executed that at times one feels as if one were in the Basque Country itself.</p>
